Re: People v. Richard Anthony Evans

Today, in Department 8 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Wendy G. Getty, the jury found the defendant, Richard Anthony Evans, guilty of sodomy with a child 10 years of age or less in violation of Penal Code section 288.7(a), and two counts of sexual penetration with a child 10 years of age or less in violation of 288.7(b). Between November 2015 through February 2016, the defendant molested two young girls while he was home watching them after school. The 9 year old victim finally told her mother what occurred and her mother contacted the police. During the investigation, Suisun Police Officers interviewed the defendant, and he admitted to molesting both minor victims. The brave 9 year old victim, now 10 years old, testified at the trial. The defendant is scheduled to be sentenced on May 15, 2017, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 8. The defendant is facing 55 years to life in state prison.



Detective Lisa Carlock, Officers Stephen Brown and Bryan Hamilton of the Suisun Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Ilana Jacobs. Cynthia Malloy was the victim advocate.
