The Court makes the following additional orders:

If the obligor is incarcerated or in a residential treatment program for 90 or more consecutive days, or receives SSI or monetary public assistance, and has no other sources of income, child support shall be set at \$0.00 per month beginning the first day of the month following the first day of incarceration or entry into a residential treatment program or receipt of SSI or monetary public assistance benefits. The child support shall resume in the prior court ordered amount effective the first month following the occurrence of any of the following: the date the obligor is released from incarceration or released from a residential treatment program or terminated from SSI or monetary public assistance.

Pursuant to Family Code Section 4504, if the Obligor's child support obligation is currently being fully or partially satisfied by the payment of social security derivative or veterans benefits to the minor child(ren) due to obligor's disability, the benefit shall be credited toward the amount of support ordered and may be adjusted periodically to reflect any change in said benefits effective the date the benefits are first paid.

In the event that the obligor becomes employed, changes residence, telephone number and/or employer, he/she shall notify orally the Solano County Department of Child Support Services at 675 Texas St, Ste 5700, Fairfield CA 94533-6372 within forty-eight (48) hours of the name, address, telephone number and rate of pay for each new employer. The oral notice shall be followed up with a WRITTEN notice within ten (10) days. The same notice requirement shall apply to the obligor's receipt of any assets and/or funds.

Notwithstanding 6.b.(3) of a Default Judgment entered pursuant to FC Section 17430, in cases where cash aid is active, this order shall begin on the first day of the month following the entry of said Default Judgment. This order shall not apply to any Stipulations for Judgment or Judgments taken or entered in Court.
