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## MEANINGFUL USE INFORMATION FOR ELIGIBLE PROVIDERS AND ELIGIBLE HOSPITALS IN SOLANO COUNTY

To receive the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Electronic Health Record (EHR) incentive for meaningful use, Eligible Professionals (EPs) and Eligible Hospitals (EHs) must meet the public health objective requirements. This is to declare that, as of October 1, 2013, Solano County Public Health has the capacity to receive electronic transmission of immunization, laboratory, and syndromic surveillance data from EPs and EHs as outlined by CMS. Specialized and cancer registries will be supported before the end of the calendar year. Solano County is **NOT** using the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Health Information Exchange (HIE) Gateway; therefore, EPs and EHs must register with, and provide **all** the above-mentioned data to, Solano County Public Health.
