DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board receive a presentation by First 5 Solano/County Administrator's Office on the selection of Minda Krueger as the December 2010 "Employee of the Month" for the County Administration Center parking program, making her eligible to use the parking space designated for this honor.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

In December 2006, the Board of Supervisors approved an ongoing County Administration Center (CAC) "Employee of the Month" parking program for County employees.

December 2010 has been designated as the month for the County Administrator's Office (CAO) to recognize one of our exemplary employees. First 5 Solano, which is administratively a division of the CAO, recently relocated to the CAC campus, making First 5 employees eligible for consideration for this program. Minda Krueger, an Office Assistant II, is being honored for her exemplary service to First 5 and to the community. Ms. Krueger, who was hired by Solano County in August 28, 2006, has been with First 5 Solano since October 22, 2007. Ms. Krueger's efficiency, courtesy, accuracy and initiative are just a few of her outstanding qualities. She supports the First 5 staff, Commissioners and community partners in their efforts to improve the health, safety, well-being and quality of life for Solano County's children aged 0-5 and their families.
