DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION:

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Carole Paterson began her career in 1975 as the first 4-H Staff Assistant for the Solano County 4-H Youth Development Program. In 1980, the University of California at Davis appointed her as the 4-H Youth Development Advisor for the Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources with the Cooperative Extension and in 2005, she was appointed as the Solano County Director.

Director Paterson has dedicated her career to assisting Solano County citizens through projects and workshops that focus on healthy lifestyles for children, youth and families; leadership and community development for young people; workforce preparation, science education and civic governance for adolescents; and as a facilitator.

FINANCING:

The cost of providing the resolution is included in the Clerk of the Board's budget.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose not to recognize Director Paterson; however, that is not recommended as this is an opportunity to honor Carole Paterson for her years of dedicated service to Solano County.
