In 1998, Child Welfare League of America launched a public awareness campaign to direct attention to the tragedy of violent child deaths as part of a national initiative to reduce child mortality. Each year, on the last Friday in April communities across the United States raise The Children's Memorial Flag honoring each lost child and raising public awareness about the continuing problem of violence against children. The symbol of this observance will be the presentation and display of the Children's Memorial Flag. The flag is a simple, moving image--a red field depicting blue, paper-doll-like figures of children holding hands. In the center, the white chalk outline of a missing child symbolizes the children lost to violence.
