Project Title: I-80/W. Texas Bicycle-Pedestrian Path & Bus Pullout

Project Location(s): City of Fairfield

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The purpose of the proposed project is to provide a new in-line bus stop at the I-80/W. Texas westbound entrance ramp to accommodate SolanoExpress service between the Fairfield Transit Center (FTC) and BART. The project will also provide a bicycle/pedestrian connection from the FTC to the new SolanoExpress bus stop. The project will save approximately 8 minutes per bus and connect Sacramento and Solano County cities to three BART Stations: Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill, and El Cerrito Del Norte.

Proposed improvements include bicycle-pedestrian path, bus pad, pedestrian push buttons and countdown heads, pavement markings, crosswalks and curb ramps. Construction activities will generally consist of concrete and asphalt paving, relocating or installing Caltrans electrical facilities such as lighting and signal modifications, relocating or resetting utilities and drainage facilities, removing or constructing curb & gutter and curb ramps, relocating or installing roadside signs, striping and pavement markings, and the installation of bus shelters.
