On behalf of the Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) comprising the Solano Subbasin GSA Collaborative (Collaborative), as listed below, pursuant to California Water Code Section 10728.4, the Collaborative hereby give notice to the legislative body of any city or county within the geographic area covered by the pending Solano Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) that it intends to adopt the GSP for the Solano Subbasin no earlier than 90-days upon your receipt of this notice. A map of the GSP area is included herein.

Considerations to adopt the Draft GSP shall occur as part of public hearings to be held jointly or individually by the undersigned GSAs. Once adopted, the GSP will govern sustainable groundwater management actions within each GSA's jurisdictional boundaries located within the Solano Subbasin.

Recipients of this notice may request to consult on the GSP. These requests must be received within 30 calendar days upon receipt of this notice.
