




2018 - 2019 Needs Assessments and Landscape Analysis


Sought Help for Self-Reported Mental/Emotional and/or Alcohol-Drug Issue(s)



Potential Outcomes

- Pilot and beta testing will occur with over 100 residents and service providers
- Community workers will be engaged
- Monitoring data can be used to give feedback to providers and potentially fill gaps in services (i.e. pet care in Louisville)
- User data by type of services and severity of mental health will be tracked




Community-Based Mobile Crisis Service Utilization FY 2021/22 (July 1- Sept 8, 2021)



Risk Category FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)




Law Enforcement Referral Source FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)






Service Users by Age FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)




Service Users by Race FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)




Service Users Compared to County Population by Race/Ethnicity Services by Race/Ethnicity FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)




Service Users by Primary Language FY 21/22 (July 1-Sept 8, 2021)






CSU Admission Status (July 1, 2021 – Sept 14, 2021)
