## INFORMATION RELEASE SUSPECTS ARRRESTED, GUNS AND NARCOTICS SEIZED

Early this morning, after 1 a.m., Solano County Sheriff Deputy Coy Caulfield observed a suspicious van. Deputy Caulfield followed the van, when the driver abruptly turned into a driveway in the 200 block of Home Acres Avenue. As the van pulled into the driveway, it struck a support pole of the carport. The driver exited the van and ran. At the same time, an occupant in another vehicle parked in the same area exited his vehicle and ran. The initial driver was later identified as, Justin Gregory Razle and the person who fled from the second vehicle was identified as Antonio Tavares. Caulfield waited for additional deputies and conducted an area check for the suspects. During the area check, Caulfield spoke with an elderly female who stated she was alone in her residence. The elderly female acted in a way that caused Deputy Caulfield to feel she may be in danger.

Deputy Caulfield and other deputies entered the female's residence to insure her safety. The Deputies located several people inside the residence including the driver of the van, Justin Razle, and the occupant of the other vehicle that had initially fled, Antonio Tavares. During the initial search, Caulfield observed a modified rifle, a handgun and what appeared to be narcotics packaged for sale. Deputies detained the occupants and Detectives from the Solano County California Multijurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team (Cal-MMET) responded to the scene. A search warrant was issued for the residence and served prior to 9 a.m.

During the service of the search warrant, detectives seized approximately 1 ounce of Heroin, 3 grams Methamphetamine, 9.3 grams of Marijuana and two firearms. The persons below were arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail on the following felony charges: 27 year old Vallejo resident JUSTIN GREGORY RAZLE for possession of Heroin for sale, possession of a stolen firearm, and committing a felony while out on bail with bail set at \$40,000, 31 year old American Canyon resident ANTONIO TAVARES for possession of Marijuana for sale, with bail set at \$15,000, 61 year old Vallejo resident KIMBERLY CORONEL for possession of Heroin for sale, with bail set at \$25,000, and 19 year old Vallejo resident CANDACE SIERRA CONWAY-NOEL for a stolen vehicle warrant and probation violation. Noel was held with a no-bail status due to her probation violation.

Justin Razle and Kimberly Coronel are scheduled to appear in the Fairfield Courthouse on Thursday January 22, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. Candace Conway-Noel's court appearance is scheduled for Wednesday, January 21, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. Antonio Tavares posted the required bail and is set to appear on Monday, February 2, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. in the Fairfield Courthouse.
