Re: People v. Carissa Aldrich

Today, in Department 17 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Judge Peter B. Foor presiding, the jury found the defendant, Carissa Aldrich, guilty of Count 1 in violation of Penal Code Section 192(b). On October 25, 2015, the defendant called 911 to report that she could not awaken her husband. Firefighters arrived to find the victim deceased and the kitchen littered with bloody towels and clothes. The investigation revealed that the defendant's 10 year old son stabbed the victim in the abdomen while the victim was engaged in a verbal dispute with the defendant the prior evening. The defendant rendered aid to the victim but failed to summon competent medical care for over seven hours. The victim eventually bled to death before paramedics arrived. The defendant is scheduled to be sentenced on July 31, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 17 of the Solano County Superior Court.
