## FREE PERTUSSIS (WHOOPING COUGH) VACCINATION CLINICS IN VACAVILLE AND VALLEJO

WHAT: Solano County Public Health will be conducting two free Pertussis (Whooping

Cough) vaccination clinics this week.

WHEN/ Friday, September 17, from 4:00 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Nut Tree Plaza, 1733 East

WHERE: Monte Vista Avenue, Vacaville, during the NorthBay Healthcare Safety and

Emergency Fair; and

Saturday, September 18, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. inside Seafood City

Market, 3495 Sonoma Blvd, Vallejo

WHY: Pertussis (Whooping Cough) has reached an "epidemic level" in California

> according to health experts at the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). August and September are usually peak months for the highly contagious bacterial disease which is characterized by severe coughing.

WHO: The free clinics are open to anyone age 7 or older seeking a Pertussis

vaccination.
