Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Solano Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted an application package from Recology Vallejo to revise the current SWFP to operate a Large Volume Transfer/Processing facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of Solano.

Description of Project

The Recology Vallejo facility is currently permitted to receive up to 300 tons per day (tpd) mixed recyclables (cans, bottles, paper, etc.) and "organics" (green and food waste). Under the proposed permit revision the facility would be allowed to increase the permitted daily tonnage received to a maximum 600 tpd of mixed recyclables and organics. The proposed permit revision would also increase the hours of receipt of material to 5:00AM – 7:00 PM, Monday through Sunday, and allow an increased traffic volume of up to 360 vehicles per day (incoming, 7-day rolling average). The current permit allows for receipt of material from 5:00 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday and traffic volume of up to 199 vehicles per day (incoming, 7-day rolling average).

The proposed increase in capacity, hours and traffic would enable Recology Vallejo to process additional residential and commercial recyclables and organic materials from surrounding areas.

If necessary, a second work shift of approximately 23 employees could be added to accommodate the increased throughput.

The proposed permit revision does not include any physical modification to any existing facilities, demolition of existing facilities, construction of new facilities, or other construction activity.

The facility still would not be permitted to receive Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) or construction and demolition (C&D) materials, nor perform any composting on site.

The SWFP revision would still apply to the entire 9.36 acre property and would include both the recycling and organic waste activities.

Informational meeting

Pursuant to Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) section 21660.2 a public informational meeting on this application for a revision to the existing SWFP will be held on June 12, 2019. The purpose of the informational meeting is strictly informational - to provide information related to the proposed permit, describe the process and timeline for permit issuance and provide an opportunity for the public to provide input into the permitting process. No official decisions will be made at this meeting.
