Subject: Biweekly Update of Significant Issues

1. County Administrator's Update on Contracts

The County Administrator did not sign any contracts of significance since the last Significant Issues update.

2. Statewide Service Provider for Child Support Payments to Change on February 6

As required by the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act (PRWORA), all states are required to operate a state disbursement unit (SDU) for collections and disbursement of all child support payments. In 2004, California Department of Child Support Services entered into a contract with Bank of America to provide this service. Effective February 6, 2012, SDU operations will transition to the new service provide, Affiliated Computer Services (ACS).

Customers receiving child support payments through Electronic Payment Card (EPC) have been issued a new Debit MasterCard card that will be supported by Wells Fargo Bank. Once activated, customers will receive the following new services:

- Option to receive deposit notification and low balance alert by email, phone or text messaging
- Self-service access to account information via the web
- Expanded service at any MasterCard Member bank teller location
- MasterCard Marketplace benefits
- More ATM locations

Current VISA EPC cards will continue to be supported by Bank of America until the card has a zero balance.

Child Support payments by check or money order will continue to be mailed to CA SDU, P.O. Box 989067, West Sacramento, CA 95798-9067. Electronic payment options for employers, non-custodial parents and direct deposit for Custodial Parties will continue to be offered.

3. WIB Hosted Job Fair for New Salvation Army KROC Center

On Wednesday, January 18, 2012 the Workforce Investment Board (WIB) hosted a Job Fair for the Salvation Army KROC Center at the WIB's One-Stop Career Center in Fairfield.

The Job Fair was held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and was attended by 382 job seekers. Participants were able to attend information sessions, which included a presentation about the overall operations of the facility; and, break-out sessions with information on the job opportunities in different departments such as Clerical Operations, Member & Guest Services, Sports and Fitness, Youth Programs, and Food Service. News coverage included Channel 31 Good Day Sacramento and Fox News Channel 40.

This new facility is scheduled to open in late spring this year. The Kroc Center's 60,000 sq. ft. of program space will offer state-of-the-art fitness and aquatic centers, a large kitchen, a multi-use gymnasium, dining facilities, and a new theater.

4. Federal Fiscal Year 2011 Performance for Solano County Child Support Services

The Solano County Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) collected \$37,957,844 in child support during the Federal Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2011. This represents a slight increase when compared to last year. Of the \$37.9 million in child support collected, over \$30.3 million was distributed directly to families. For many families, especially those with low incomes, child support is an indispensable source of income used to meet the essential needs of children. The remaining \$7.6 million was distributed to the State and Federal government as reimbursement for child support collected while the child was receiving public assistance.

Solano County DCSS met or exceeded all goals set by State DCSS on the five Federal Performance Measures.

5. County Vacancy Rate

There were 2,515.10 allocated positions in the County as of the January 12, 2012 pay period, of which 183.85 or 7.31% were vacant. Departments obtained authorization to fill 106 of those vacant positions, which represents a vacancy rate of 4.35% for requested positions.
