03/17/20- All Day Use, Public Events, and Youth Group Areas were closed

03/27/20- All remaining public access operations were cancelled

05/04/20- Limited operations for Boat Launch Access Only return to Beldens Landing, Lake Solano and Sandy Beach

05/16/20- Lynch Canyon reopens with phase one protocols

05/29/20- Lynch Canyon Returns to normal operating schedule

06/22/20- Limited Day Use and Campground operations return to Lake Solano

Current status:

Beldens Landing is open for Launch and Leave access only  
-No day use (bank fishing)

Lake Solano is open for day use and campground access at reduced levels.

-No boat rentals, youth group camp rentals, group picnic pad rentals, or docent led events

Lynch Canyon is open its normal hours and days

-Picnic tables beyond the staging area are not in service

Sandy Beach is open for Launch and Leave Access only

-No day use, beach or campground access
