Acceptable specimens	 Dacron-tipped nasopharyngeal swab (preferred) Nasal aspirate in a sterile container Dry nasopharyngeal swab or nasopharyngeal swab transported in Regan-Lowe or charcoal Amies medium
	Note: Cotton- or calcium alginate-tipped swabs are not acceptable. Swabs or aspirates should not be transferred into viral transport medium or universal transport medium.
Timing of specimen collection	Specimens can be collected for up to 3 weeks after symptom onset, as long as antibiotic therapy has not been initiated.
Specimen storage	Specimens should be kept refrigerated at 2–8°C for up to 72 hours after collection, and frozen thereafter (repeated freezing and thawing is not acceptable).
Specimen shipping	Specimens should be shipped refrigerated (2–8°C) and received by the laboratory within 72 hours of collection.
