

REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000, et. seq. of the California Public Resources Code, hereafter CEQA) requires analysis of agency approvals of discretionary "projects." A "project," under CEQA, is defined as "the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment." The proposed action is a project under CEQA and is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 "Existing Facilities", consisting of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use, example (c): existing highways and streets, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. This project is also categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15302 "Replacement or Reconstruction", consisting of the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.

The project is fully within public right of way and is for improvements within the existing location of the public roadway. The improvements will not result in changes to the location, size, purpose and capacity of the roadway.
