## FREE FLU, PERTUSSIS (WHOOPING COUGH), AND PNEUMONIA VACCINATION **CLINIC OFFERED SATURDAY IN VALLEJO**

WHAT: Solano County Public Health will be conducting a free seasonal flu, pertussis,

and pneumonia vaccination clinic this weekend in Vallejo.

WHEN: Saturday, January 8, 2011

TIME: 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

WHY: Influenza vaccination is recommended for all Californians six months of age or

> older. This year's vaccine offers protection against the H1N1 strain and two additional seasonal influenza strains, H3N2 and Influenza B. The Centers for Disease Control on January 3 stated that the number of hospital visits for flu

symptoms has risen for five consecutive weeks.

WHO: The free clinic is open to anyone seeking a seasonal flu vaccination. People ages

> 7 years and older may receive a pertussis vaccination. For those 65 years and older or with qualifying health conditions, a pneumonia vaccination will also be

available.
