Suspect Confesses to Brutal Murder

On Wednesday, May 6th, 2015, Hendricks County Sheriff's Office (Danville, Indiana) requested assistance from the Solano County Sheriff's Office Investigations Bureau in locating a person of interest for a brutal homicide that occurred in their jurisdiction in 2002. Detectives from Hendricks County received a CODIS hit (Combined DNA Index System), possibly linking DNA collected at the scene to the DNA with the suspect, Amado Saludes, AKA Marco Galindo. Detectives believed Saludes was living somewhere in Solano County. Several addresses were checked in attempt to locate Saludes with negative results.

On Tuesday, September 8th, 2015, the Solano County Sheriff's Enforcement Team (SET) contacted a male subject, who was later identified as Saludes, and subsequently arrested him on a traffic warrant for an unrelated case. Solano County detectives immediately began working with the detectives from Hendricks County and assisted in obtaining a DNA sample from Saludes. Due to the nature of the warrant Saludes was arrested on, and the likely ability he could post bail in a short amount of time, Hendricks County detectives requested Saludes be interviewed by Solano County detectives.

After several hours of talking to Saludes, he admitted to being responsible for the homicide and provided details only the killer would have known. Saludes was booked into the Solano County Jail for 1551(a) PC – Fugitive from justice, with a no-bail status. A Ramey Arrest warrant from Hendricks County was obtained. Saludes was booked for murder, and is pending extradition.

The joint effort of all agencies has resulted in the arrest of a very dangerous and brutal murderer. We hope this helps brings closure to the family of the victim, Natalie Horsley.
