

Re: People v. Adolph Greene

On Thursday, August 3, 2017, in Department 4 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Judge E. Bradley Nelson, the jury found the defendant, Adolph Greene, guilty of Carrying a Concealed Dirk or Dagger in violation of Penal Code Section 21310. On May 20, 2017, Fairfield Police Officer Pavel Del Monte saw Defendant riding his bicycle on the sidewalk of North Texas Street. Defendant was contacted for the bicycle violation. Officer Del Monte then did a compliance search of Defendant because he was on probation. Officer Del Monte found a knife with a three-inch blade in Defendant's rear jeans pocket. The knife was completely concealed in the pocket. He is scheduled to be sentenced on September 26, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 4.

Officer Pavel Del Monte of the Fairfield Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Kevin Cunnane.
