## Three Arrested on Drug Charges/Child Endangerment Solano County Sheriff's Office

August 7, 2008

On Wednesday afternoon, August 6, following a month long investigation the Solano County Sheriff's Office Cal-MMET/Sol-NET unit (California Multi Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team-Solano Narcotics Enforcement Team) located its primary subject, 30 year old Alvin Deman Spades at a business located on Magazine Street in the City of Vallejo. Simultaneously a search warrant was being executed at his apartment complex residence, located on the 100 block of Cypress, in unincorporated Vallejo. Located at the residence was 1½ ounces of Cocaine and \$4,700 in cash. Detained and subsequently arrested was Spades wife, 26 year old Jasmine Nicole Anderson. Both Spade and Anderson were booked into the Solano County Jail on charges of Possession of Cocaine for Sale, Conspiracy and Child Endangerment. Spade was additionally charged with an enhancement for prior drug convictions. Four children ranging in ages from 1 week to approximately 4 years old were removed from the home, and placed in the care of Child Protective Services. Spade has since posted a \$76,666 bail, and is no longer in custody. Anderson also has since posted a \$41,667 bail, and is no longer in custody.

Also arrested at the residence was Vallejo resident 45 year old Marilyn Marie Jones. Ms. Jones was found to have rock cocaine on her person, and is being held in the Solano County Jail on a bail amount of \$10,000. She is scheduled to be arraigned in the Solano County Superior Court on August 8, 2008 at 1:30 p.m.
