Who is eligible for a CHDP Exam?

- Low income children birth to 19 years
- Children with Medi-Cal birth to 21 years

Proof of residency and income is not required.

Babies, children and teens should have regular health exams — even if they are not sick.

CHDP exams can:

- Help keep children healthy
- Identify medical and dental problems early

All CHDP exams include:

- Growth and development check
- Immunizations (shots)
- Teeth and gum check
- Hearing and vision test
- Nutrition check
- Tests for anemia, lead, and others
- Health education

The CHDP Gateway

The CHDP Gateway is a way to help children get health insurance.
Uninsured children can get their CHDP exam and may be enrolled into temporary Medi-Cal.

This health insurance coverage is only temporary. A parent or guardian must complete a Medi-Cal application to continue this health insurance coverage.
