## **NITRATE WATER TESTING**

**SAMPLE COLLECTION:** Water samples taken for nitrate testing must be collected and handled properly in order to insure reliability of laboratory results. The following procedures will help you in this regard:

- 1. Select a tap as close to the well as possible. When you have found a suitable faucet, open it and allow the water to flow for 1-2 minutes before collecting a sample.
- 2. Carefully fill the plastic container provided by the laboratory.
- 3. Fill out the sample label on the bottle with the sample location, date and time of collection.
- 4. Complete the laboratory form including the sample location, sample site, date and time of collection, collector's name, chlorine level (if applicable) mailing address, contact phone number, water test requested (i.e. "Nitrates"), and any county and/or state departments that you would like a copy of the results sent.

**CARE OF SAMPLE**: Nitrate samples **must be tested within 48 hours of collection and kept refrigerated**. To assure that this time limit is met, **it is preferable to submit the sample directly to the laboratory on Tuesdays only** (8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.) at the following health department offices (water submission times vary between locations, please see listing below:

• Special ion testing that requires send-out to Monterey Public Health Laboratory will be \$30.00 or more, plus shipping and handling.

**NITRATE RESULTS:** The Environmental Protection Agency and the State Department of Health consider 45 mg/L to be the maximum allowable level of nitrate in drinking water.
