

## Glossary of COVID-19 Dashboard Terms

Dashboard Item Name	Explanation
"Total Confirmed Cases"	The total number of laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents since the outbreak started.
"Number of Cases by Age group"	The total number of laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents in three different age groupings (0-18 year, 19-64 years, and 65+ years old). "Severe" cases are defined as those who were hospitalized or died, and "Nonsevere" are those who were not hospitalized and did not die.
"Total Deaths"	The total number of deaths occurring in laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents. This does <b>not</b> include residents of other counties who expire in facilities within Solano County.
"Cases confirmed today"	The total number of laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents that were confirmed by Solano Public health by 1:30pm on that particular day. Please note weekend confirmations may occur on Monday.
"Active Cases"	The total number of laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents who are still within 7 days of when their specimens were collected.
"Total hospitalizations"	The total number of laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County residents who were hospitalized for their illness with COVID-19 since the outbreak started.
"Nearby Counties"	The number of COVID-19 cases and deaths in 10 nearby counties: Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, Sacramento, San Francisco, San Joaquin, Santa Clara, Sonoma, and Yolo Counties.

"Daily number of cases on the date that specimens	An epidemic curve of the number of laboratory-
were collected"	confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Solano County
	residents, by the date that their specimens were
	collected. Epidemic curves best represent an
	epidemic's trajectory when charted by symptom
	onset date. Because symptom onset date is not
	available for every case, specimen collection date is
	being used as a proxy.
"Cumulative number of cases on the date reported	The running total number of cases of laboratory-
to Solano Public Health"	confirmed COVID-19 on the date received and
	confirmed by Solano Public Health.
