### **DELAYED PAYMENTS**

The IRS has extended the deadline to file taxes to July 15<sup>th</sup>. The Franchise Tax Board has extended the deadline for state taxes to July 15<sup>th</sup> as well. The Federal Government has announced that student loan payments are being delayed for 60 days from March 13<sup>th</sup>. Interest will not accrue during this time.

### **COUNTY PROPERTY TAXES**

As of now, property taxes are due in April. The county is not able to delay the payment. We need the state to do this. I have written a letter to State Controller Betty Yee asking her to do all that she can to delay the tax payments.

5) Purchase Tolenas Wine and assorted Beer outside of the Deli from 3pm-6pm on Saturday, Mar 21 (Must be 21 years of age or older)

#1 Dinner Package Grilled BBQ Chicken, Green Beans, Mashed Potatoes, Rolls (feeds 5-6 people, already cooked, just reheat in your oven) \$45

#2 Dinner Package BBQ Pulled Pork, Coleslaw, Mashed Potatoes, Rolls (feeds 5-6 people, already cooked, just reheat in your oven) \$45

#3 GROCERY GOODIE BAG (includes all of the following) \$70: 5 rolls toilet paper, 1 roll paper towel, ½ Lb sliced ham, ½ Lb sliced cheese, ½ Lb bacon, dozen eggs, ½ gallon 2% Milk, 1 loaf wheat bread, 2 heads romaine lettuce, 2 Lbs red potatoes, 2 yellow onions, 2 tomatoes, 1 cucumber, 4 bananas, 3 oranges!
