The Board of Supervisors unanimously approved a spending plan for money the county has received from the CARES Act. We are limited in what we can use this money on, we must spend it by the end of the calendar year, and we are subject to strict reporting requirements. If any of the expenses are not approved by the federal government, the county will be forced to repay that money back out of the general fund.
