VACCINES

I know that we all want to get the vaccine. While we have made progress on vaccinating our residents, the hard truth continues to be that we simply do not have enough vaccines to vaccinate everyone currently eligible. The cold weather in other parts of the country has slowed down shipments of vaccines all over the country. That should be completely resolved next week.

The Johnson & Johnson vaccine should be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) soon. Since this is a one dose vaccine, it should dramatically improve our nation's ability to provide vaccines. I am hopeful that in the next few months, the country will have enough supply to provide a vaccine to anyone who wants one.

IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT EVERYONE SIGN UP FOR THE VACCINE NOTIFICATION FORM. This form is where the county will be pulling names for future vaccine events. I cannot overemphasize how important it is that everyone sign up for the vaccine interest form. This is what the county will use to notify residents of future vaccine events.

If you are in an eligible tier, you may be able to get vaccinated at La Clinica in Vallejo, at a Safeway Pharmacy, Walgreens, or at CVS.
