I want to provide you with information about upcoming vaccination events this week. Solano County has expanded eligibility to include those 50-64 years of age with pre-existing conditions. These events will be at the Fairgrounds. Eligibility has also been expanded to include those who work in jails, the homeless/unhoused, transportation workers, and more.
