SUBJECT: ASBESTOS FIBERS DISCLOSURE

All buildings constructed prior to 1979 that are owned or leased by the County of Solano, in which you, as an employee, either work or conduct business, may contain asbestos construction materials (ACM's). These ACM's are generally comprised of floor, tiles, ceiling tiles and pipe materials, all of which may contain asbestos fibers.

California law requires that we provide you with the information contained in this letter relative to ACM's. Additionally, Risk Management and/or Facilities Management are available to present informational workshops for employees who have specific questions regarding ACM's in the workplace.

The County has not conducted a recent, individual survey of its buildings to determine the scope and extent of ACM'S present. However, the County is aware, through its regular maintenance program that ACM's are present in specific buildings as listed on Exhibit A. This list is not a complete list and only includes areas specifically recognized. However, ACM's generally exist in some form in any building constructed prior to 1979.

We do not have any knowledge of the potential health risks presented by any presence of ACM's in County-owned buildings and we do not know of any County buildings which require special handling restrictions. If ACM's are suspected, please do not disturb the material but contact the Facilities & Operations Division of General Services. As the County becomes aware of specific special handling requirements for any area, the area will be posted and employees located in the area notified of those requirements. You are encouraged to contact the Solano County Environmental Health Services Division at (707) 784-6765 with any questions or health concerns you may have regarding ACM's in the work place.
