WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH

For this week, I want to recognize Vallejo Councilmember Mina Diaz and Civil Rights Activist Delores Huerta.

MINA DIAZ

Councilmember Diaz began her term on the Vallejo City Council this year. Councilmember Diaz founded the Diaz and Loera Centro Latino in Vallejo to provide resources to the community. Councilmember Diaz successfully advocated for the city of Vallejo to declare itself a safe haven for immigrants. Councilmember Diaz also assisted my office in our unsuccessful attempt to have Solano County declared a safe haven.

Councilmember Diaz's work in Vallejo has provided a voice to those who have not been heard for far too long. She has been a great partner as a community advocate and that continues in her new role as an elected official.

DELORES HUERTA

Delores Huerta cofounded the United Farm Workers union with Cesar Chavez. Ms. Huerta's actions helped improve the working conditions of farm workers in California. She was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom and was the first Latina inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame. I remember not buying grapes in the 60's because of the UFW boycott.
