VACCINES

I am sure many of you have heard that the state will be doing away with the tiered approach an opening eligibility to everyone 16 and up on April 15th. It is extremely important to remember that *ELIGIBILITY DOES NOT NECESSARILY MEAN AVAILABILITY*. The county's ability to provide vaccines will depend completely on the supply we are given. I will do my best to keep provide information as it becomes available.
