VACCINATIONS

The pause on the use of J&J has reduced our supply of vaccine. Previously scheduled mass vaccination events that were intended to use the J&J vaccine are now using either Pfizer or Moderna. While no vaccination event was cancelled, redeploying our Pfizer and Moderna vaccines limits our ability to plan future events in the short term.

I know it is extremely frustrating to have our vaccine supply reduced right as we are opening eligibility and two months before the state is scheduled to reopen. I personally received the J&J vaccine before the pause and do not regret receiving it. I have every confidence in the J&J vaccine. However, I understand and respect that the experts are taking this time to look at the issues and ensure safety. These high standards are essential to ensure trust in our health care systems. I hope when the review is concluded, we will be able to continue administering the J&J vaccine.

At the Board of Supervisors' meeting this past Tuesday, the Board gave final approval to implement the Home Kitchen program in Solano County. The Board previously approved the program, but delayed implementation because of COVID. Now, the Board has approved implementation in line with COVID restrictions. I believe this program will provide opportunities to our residents, especially to our military spouses at Travis Air Force Base.

The program allows anyone who has received a permit from the county and complies with the requirements to sell food made in their home. I will be providing more information as the county begins accepting permits.
