VACCINES

It is extremely important that we get as many people vaccinated as possible. The largest share of our new Covid infections in Solano County are in the age groups of 18-49. We are also seeing lower vaccination rates in those age groups than others. We are expecting the Pfizer vaccine to be approved for those 12 and up very soon. We plan to schedule vaccine events for those in that age group with parental permission when the FDA gives approval.

Please encourage everyone you know to get vaccinated. Vaccines are extremely important to stopping this virus. There will be a vaccine event at the Filipino Community Center in Vallejo on May 13th from 2-7pm. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson will be available. TRAFFIC CHANGES IN FAIRFIELD

This information is from Caltrans: "Caltrans Bay Area will be permanently closing northbound Red Top Road at State Route 12(SR-12) near Fairfield, Solano County starting on the week of May 10, 2021 as part of the highway safety improvements for the I-80/I-680/SR-12 Interchange Project. This will eliminate the left turn movement from NB Red Top Road to WB SR-12 towards Napa County. Motorists are advised to take EB I-80 to the Green Valley Road exit, crossover the freeway and take the on-ramp to WB I-80/WB SR-12 towards Napa. Motorists will be allowed to make a right turn from EB SR-12 onto Red Top Road." Please remember this as you drive.
