CORONAVIRUS

I know all of us are beyond tired of the toll this pandemic has taken on our nation. It is important that we continue to take the steps necessary to protect our community in the face of the delta strain. The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has stated this strain will spread as easily as the chickenpox. It is important to get vaccinated and wear masks when we are in public.

There has been a lot of talk about Solano's public health department not joining the Bay Area public health departments in issuing a mask recommendation. The CDC has issued a recommendation that masks be worn in areas with high spread of the virus. Solano County is an area where the CDC recommends wearing masks in public places.

Regardless of what our local health department recommends, I support the CDC recommendation and urge everyone to wear masks while they are at indoor public places or in crowded outdoor places. Aside from all the people who have chosen not to get vaccinated (which is substantial unfortunately), we have children under 12 and immunocompromised adults who are not able to get vaccinated. CALTRANS CLOSURE ON I-80 AND HIGHWAY 29 AND HIGHWAY 37

From Cal Trans: Caltrans Bay Area will be working on WB/EB Interstate 80(I-80) at State Route 29 (SR-29) as crews start bridge demolition work for two consecutive night starting on Saturday, July 31, 2021- Monday, August 2, 2021.

Crews will be closing the EB I-80 and SR-29 connector ramp overnight starting at 11:59 PM on Saturday, July 31, 2021 until 10:00 AM, Sunday, August 1, 2021. The work will be continued Sunday overnight starting at 11:59 PM until 6:00 AM, Monday, August 2, 2021.

Motorists are encouraged to use EB I-780 (Curtola Pkwy) off-ramp to WB Lemon Street to State Route 29 (Sonoma Blvd.)

As part of a two-week roadway repair project, starting Monday, August 2, Caltrans will alternate overnight full highway closures on westbound and eastbound State Route 37 (SR-37) between Walnut Ave. on Mare Island in Vallejo and State Route 121 (SR-121) near Sears Point and the Sonoma Raceway in Sonoma County.

At least one travel direction of SR-37 will remain open at all times.

Nationwide, the eviction moratorium ends July 31. In California, our moratorium ends Sept. 30. In Solano, the eviction moratorium ends 90 days after the State ends their State of Emergency declaration. I hope this timeline helps to bring down the anxiety level.
