May 9	E – 29	First day vote-by-mail ballots are available for in-person early voting.
May 23	E – 15	15-day close of registration.

May 24	E – 14	Statement of write-in candidacy period ends.
May 26	E – 12	Second pre-election deadline for campaign filing form 460 [by statute].
