CORONAVIRUS

I am so tired of writing about the pandemic. I am sure all of you are tired of reading these updates with information about the pandemic. Our healthcare workers are even more tired of the strain this has placed on them. Our hospitals are still filling up with unvaccinated people and pushing out people who need healthcare for issues other than COVID-19.

I want to thank all of you who have gotten vaccinated, who wear your masks and who are doing what needs to be done to get past this. I know most of our community has stepped up and taken the steps necessary to protect our community.

If you have not been vaccinated, I plead with you to get vaccinated. If you are unvaccinated, you are at extremely high risk of catching the virus. As of the most recent count, 79% of those testing positive in Solano County are not vaccinated. The unvaccinated are 17x more likely to be hospitalized. As I have said and as we have heard many times, this is a pandemic of the unvaccinated. Your health is in serious jeopardy if you are not vaccinated.

If you are not vaccinated, please go to one of our vaccine events, to the mall, to your local pharmacy, to your doctor or anywhere they are offering vaccines and get one. If you know people who are not vaccinated, please encourage them to get vaccinated. We are all in this together and we will only get out of this together.
