The Solano County Airport Land Use Commission met on December 9, 2021 in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers at the Solano County Government Center, 675 Texas Street, Fairfield, California, at 7:00 p.m.

Staff present were Resource Management Director Terry Schmidtbauer, Deputy County Counsel Lori Mazzella, Principal Planner Jim Leland and Clerk Marianne Richardson.

APPROVAL OF REMOTE TELECONFERENCING

1 <u>AC 21-035</u> Public Hearing to consider a resolution authorizing remote teleconference meetings for the period of December 9, 2021 to January 8, 2022 as a result of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic state of emergency

Terry Schmidtbauer, Director of Resource Management, summarized the resolution item.

Responding to a question by Commissioner Cook, Mr. Schmidtbauer stated that due to State requirements, the 30-day resolution would need to be considered at each monthly meeting.

Responding to a question by Commissioner Meyer, Mr. Schmidtbauer and Lori Mazzella, Deputy County Counsel, confirmed the resolution is for use during the COVID state of emergency.
