5.9 Longevity Compensation

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A. All employees employed in regular or limited-term full-time positions, upon the completion of ten (10) years continuous full-time service, _shall be entitled to longevity pay on the following schedule:

<u>1.</u> Upon completion of five (5) years of continuous full-time service, a \$1000.00 one-time lump sum payment;

<u>2.</u> Upon completion of ten (10) years of continuous full-time service, a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation;

3. Upon completion of fifteen (15) years of continuous full-time service, an additional two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation (a total of 5%);

<u>4. additionally, employees who complete Upon completion of twenty</u> (20) years of continuous full-time service, shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation (-a total of $\frac{5\%}{7.5\%}$);

<u>5.</u> <u>Upon completion of additionally, after</u> twenty-five (25) years of continuous full-time service, an additional two and a half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (-a total of 10%)

<u>6.</u> <u>Upon completion of additionally, employees who complete thirty</u> (30) years of continuous full-time service, shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (-a total of 12.5%) additionally effective the beginning of the pay period following Board of Supervisors adoption of this MOU, employees who complete (35) years of continuous full-time service shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (a total of 15%) over the rate for the class in which employed.
