## **Delta Tunnels: Make Your Voice Heard**





When Mark Twain was a newspaper reporter in California and Nevada, he noted that in the West, "Whiskey is for drinking and water is for fighting." Not much has changed since Twain's time, and we once again find ourselves in a fight to protect Northern California water from being drained through tunnels to the Southern California deserts.

Your voice is critical to stop this ill-conceived concept that sacrifices our drinking water, agricultural water and water desperately needed to protect the environment in our Delta. First, take a few minutes to learn more here - you can download a fact sheet to share with friends.

Second, take just a couple minutes to comment on the Environmental Impact Report for this project – it can be as simple as, "I oppose the Delta tunnels because they're bad for the environment, bad for water users and hurt locally-owned farms and ranches that provide our food."
