5.9 Longevity Compensation (Amended)

## 5.9 Longevity Compensation Pay

- A. All employees employed in regular or limited-term full-time positions, upon the completion of ten (10) years continuous full-time service, shall be entitled to longevity pay on the following schedule:
  - 1. Upon completion of five (5) years of continuous full-time service, a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation;
  - 1. Upon completion of ten (10) years of continuous full-time service, a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation;
  - 2. Upon completion of fifteen (15) years of continuous full-time service, an additional two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation (a total of 5.0%);
  - <u>additionally</u>, employees who complete <u>Upon completion of</u> twenty (20) years of continuous full-time service, shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in compensation (-a total of 5% 7.5%):
  - 4. Upon completion of additionally, after twenty-five (25) years of continuous full-time service, an additional two and a half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (-a total of 10%).
  - 6. Upon completion of additionally, employees who complete (30) years of continuous full time service, shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (a total of 12.5%) additionally effective the beginning of the pay period following Board of Supervisors adoption of this MOU, employees who complete (35) years of continuous full-time service shall be entitled to an additional two and one-half (2.5%) percent increase in compensation (a total of 15%) over the rate for the class in which employed.
