Recognizing Animal Care and Control Appreciation Week



The work of Solano County's Animal Care and Control division is more than what we always see – so we take a week each April for a national recognition of the great and often heart-wrenching work they do for families and pets, and to take a closer look at what they refer to as 'controlled chaos.'

We're all familiar with the shelter that takes in animals that are sick, abandoned or taken off the streets, and where they make every effort to rehome them. The feeling of success in watching an animal adopted is too often countered with other animals being put down. It's tough work done by a team of truly dedicated professionals and volunteers.

Their 'community-centric' approach has led to a homeless outreach project, a pet food pantry, Hip to be Tipped, Spay It Forward, redemption assistance, deferred intake, pet safety net program, foster program, and even an office dog program.

Each day, their team sees animal cruelty and abandonment, owners who can't afford to redeem their pets from the shelter or must relinquish their pets because of housing or financial constraints. They nurse back the sick and injured, help community members who need help with food and vet bills and much more.

With just one animal care and control office serving 900 square miles of land and water with a population of 450,000 people, it's a lot of work for one team. But you can help! The office is always in need of volunteers, fosters, adopters, funding, and support. You can advocate for pets and work side-by-side with them to make a powerful impact on our community. Volunteering with them has been an important part of our family life for years, and we'd love to have you join us.
