Milestones for Active and Future Grants

- •11/13 to 11/14 Royal Electric conducted assessment of the electrical lighting systems on the airfield during the two days of 4-hour morning runway closures. A report is expected in a few weeks.

- •11/28 Kick-Off Meeting for updating the Airport Layout Plan. The Consultant will be meeting with staff and FBOs on the Airfield to get information and ideas for the ALP. Beginning of an 8 month process.
