Since my time on the Vacaville City Council, I've taken a special interest in transportation issues to help our growing community address issues of traffic, safety, safe routes to schools, commuter opportunities and public transportation that meets the needs of our neighbors. I was recently appointed to represent Solano County on the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and at the annual reorganization of the Board of Supervisors, I was reappointed to serve on the Solano Transportation Authority. In both positions I'll continue to lobby for projects we need in Solano County, and right here in the 5th District.
