1. Call to order / Introductions

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Bogner at 9:08am.

2. Approval of the Minutes

The minutes of February 18, 2010 were approved.

3. Opportunity for Public Comment

a. Rick Pierce, Alternative Waste Solutions

Independent recycler that goes on-site to separate recyclables from garbage dumpsters at apartment complexes and whose fee is based on a percentage of the amount resulting from the garbage bill savings. Hauling is excluded due to franchise agreements.

b. June Guidotti, Suisun Resident

Submitted attached letter to the LTF from her attorney, William Reustle, requesting the LTF deny final roll-call comment to the second amendment to the countywide NDFE.

c. Narcisa Untal, Solano County

Solano County Superior Court Judge Beeman ruled Measure E is constitutional and that Solano County should enforce it. However, Solano County Counsel is currently evaluating Judge Beeman's ruling.

4. Discussion Items

a. Non-Disposal Facility Element (NDFE) – 2nd Amendment

The LTF discussed the final draft of the second amendment to the countywide NDFE of the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan for the Cities and County of Solano and authorized the transmittal of a letter by Chair Bogner containing the LTF's collective comment of "No Comment" based on a verbal roll-call of the members present. The jurisdictions may now proceed in the next step of the NDFE amendment process by requesting adoption of a resolution by their respective governing authority that approves the second amendment to the countywide NDFE.

b. Zero Waste Event Potrero Hills Landfill and Sierra Club

Consider establishing a committee to coordinate a countywide event focused on zero waste activities in either September or November 2010. Natalie Hicks, PHLF, offered

PHLF to lead as a major financial sponsor of the event and volunteered to serve as chair of this committee. Interested LTF members should contact Natalie to describe level of participation, both financial and administrative.

5. Speaker Presentation-Dean Rodatos, Green Halo Systems

Dean Rodatos of Green Halo Systems described a new online waste management software program that would allow contractors to create and submit waste management plans to cities; create diversion reports for county/state reporting; identify facilities for recycling while reducing carbon footprint and is free to local jurisdictions. Bay Area counties are currently trial-testing the software program.

6. Member Updates

Jane Bogner, Sierra Club

The U.S. Navy demolished an Officers' Club building which has made available several tons of glassware and miscellaneous cooking equipment to be recycled. Interested persons or parties should contact Jane Bogner.

Waste Reduction Awards Program (WRAP) application deadline is June 15 for businesses and non-profit organizations.
