

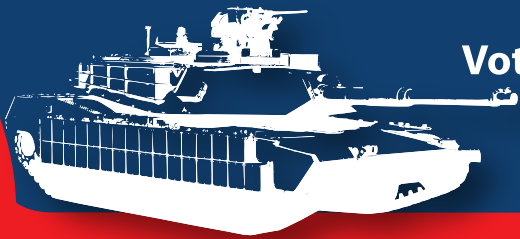
MILITARY AND OUT OF COUNTRY VOTING

UNIFORMED SERVICE MEMBERS OR U.S. CITIZENS PERMANENTLY RESIDING OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES OR U.S. CITIZENS TEMPORARILY RESIDING OUTSIDE PLACE OF RESIDENCE

For reasons of **military service, employment, study program or family relationship** are eligible to vote and **request a vote-by-mail ballot**. To register to vote and request a vote-by-mail ballot, you must complete a Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) or register online at registertovote.ca.gov.

VOTE BY MAIL VOTING INFORMATION

Ballots must be returned by 8:00 p.m. P.S.T. on Election Day, to your county of residence.

California law requires that all vote-by-mail ballots be returned by mail or fax.

If you are already a registered voter in Solano County you may submit a letter stating you are a member of the uniformed services or U.S. citizen temporarily residing outside place of residence and you wish to vote a vote-by-mail ballot. Please include the following:



1. Your name and Solano County residence address;
2. The mailing address to which your ballot is to be sent;
3. The election for which the ballot is being requested;
4. Your preferred method of receiving a ballot (fax, e-mail or standard mail);
5. Your signature.

You may also submit your request via email: elections@solanocounty.com or by fax **707-784-1424**.

FPCA forms must be received by the Registrar of Voters office on or before the deadline, seven (7) days prior to an election.

Voters outside the United States should apply as early as possible to ensure timely receipt and return of their ballots.

Voters living outside of the United States or Military voters serving in another country will be mailed a ballot between 60 and 45 days prior to an election.
