Dear CCW Training Provider:

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions placed on business there has been some confusion if we are restricting CCW training. Solano County Sheriff's Office is not prohibiting our approved training providers from providing training for our citizen's but we expect you to follow the CDC protocols and guidelines regarding COVID-19 (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prepare/prevention.html>). It is recommended that you keep class sizes to a minimum and practice social distancing.

We will continue processing all initial, renewal and modification requests. However pickups will be limited to one day a week.
