NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Energy Commission (CEC), as lead agency under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has prepared a proposed Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study for the proposed Modification of Regulations Specifying Enforcement Procedures for the Renewables Portfolio Standard for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities project.

Project Location

The proposed project is a statewide rulemaking proceeding with no physical location.

Project Description

The proposed project consists of modifying existing regulations specifying procedures for the enforcement of the Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) for local publicly owned electric utilities (POUs) under Article 16 (commencing with section 399.11) of Chapter 2.3 of Part 1 of the Public Utilities Code. The proposed regulations will update the RPS program for POUs to implement changes to RPS procurement requirements, optional compliance measures, reporting requirements, and special exemptions and exclusions. The proposed regulations will also update other aspects of the program to facilitate implementation and improve clarity.

Public Review

The Initial Study and Proposed Negative Declaration for the proposed Modification of Regulations Specifying Enforcement Procedures for the Renewables Portfolio Standard for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities are available for persons that wish to review and comment.
