**Description of Project:** Proposal to develop an approx. 32.74 acre site in the Vaca Valley Business Park, just south of the Genentech complex, into an office campus to house the operations of the State Compensation Insurance Fund. The site is just east of Interstate 505 and north of Interstate 80. The campus will consist of five separate, two story buildings of 86,875 sf each, for a total office area of 434,375 square feet and will be supported by a ground level, landscaped parking facility for up to 2,056 cars. The project is proposed to be phased with phase I consisting of the first three buildings (first phase total 260,625 sf).

**Environmental & Land Use Setting:** The site is level and currently vacant with non-native grass cover and has no evidence of prior development. The project site is within the Vaca Valley Business Park, a 360 acre master planned site located at the junction of Interstate 80 and Interstate 505, and bordered by Vaca Valley Parkway on the North. Genentech, a leading international biotechnology company, and the Kaiser medical offices and hospital (under construction) are located on other parcels in the Business Park. The Nut Tree Airport (owned and operated by Solano County) is located west of the project site, across Interstate 505.
