**Applications for Technical Expert on the  
Solano County Solid Waste Independent Hearing Panel  
Now Being Accepted**

Applications from individuals who are interested in serving as the Technical Expert on the Solano County Solid Waste Independent Hearing Panel (IHP) are currently being accepted by the Solano County Local Enforcement Agency (LEA).

The ideal candidate will have practical, technical experience in solid waste facility operations or regulatory oversight programs pertaining to solid waste facilities. Experience may be gained through employment in the solid waste industry, private sector providing services to assist in permitting or operation of solid waste facilities, or a government regulatory agency responsible for solid waste facility enforcement. Typically, the individual will have a professional license or registration, such as a Professional Engineer or Registered Environmental Health Specialist.

The position requires that the individual not have any conflict of interest resulting from employment, claim or litigation, or actions taken for or against solid waste facilities operated in Solano County or their parent companies. The IHP does not meet regularly. The Board of Supervisors has approved a \$100 per diem compensation for panel members.

Application Process:

Appointment Process:

The LEA will evaluate all applications received and will make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors for final appointment. It is anticipated that the effective date of appointment will be April 2021.

Additional Background:

The LEA is responsible for enforcement of solid waste laws and regulations pertaining to solid waste facilities in Solano County. As part of this effort and consistent with state laws and regulations, the Board of Supervisors has established an IHP to hold administrative hearings as needed by the LEA regarding action occurring at solid waste facilities or for review of LEA enforcement action.

The panel is comprised of three members: a technical expert with knowledge of solid waste management and technology, a public at large member and a member of the Board of Supervisors. All members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors for a four-year term, and may serve more than one term, but no more than two consecutive terms.
