REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000, et. seq. of the California Public Resources Code, hereafter CEQA) requires analysis of agency approvals of discretionary "projects." A "project," under CEQA, is defined as "the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment." The proposed action is a project under CEQA and is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 "Existing Facilities", 15302 "Replacement and Reconstruction", and 15303 "New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures." The project is fully within public right of way and is for the construction of new, small facilities or structures within the existing location of a park. The park will remain a neighborhood park and construction of the new facilities and structures will not result in changes to the location, size, purpose and capacity of the park. Moreover, the project will plant trees appropriate for a neighborhood park, and will not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
